COMPLIANCE EXTENSION REQUEST

<u>Applicable Rule</u>: 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart A - National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) – General Provisions

This form fulfills the requirements necessary to request an extension of compliance under 112(d) of the Clean Air Act (CAA) as specified in §63.6(i) and §63.9(c) of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). The deadline by which a request for an extension of compliance with a relevant standard must be received is **no later than 120 days** <u>before the compliance date of the standard*</u> [as specified in §63.6(b) and (c)]. The amount of time requested for the extension request cannot exceed one (1) year.

*Please note that emissions standards established under this part may specify an alternative date (e.g., other than 120 days) for the submittal of requests for an extension of compliance if alternatives are appropriate for the source categories affected by those standards. Please check the relevant standard for alternative submittal dates (§63.6(i)(4)(i)(B)).
