Initial Notification

Sources must submit Initial Notifications by the applicable dates shown in italics below.

Notice of Intent to Test

Compliance Status Notification

Sources must submit their Notification of Compliance Status Report within 180 days of their applicable compliance date.

Compliance Reports

For Major Sources

- Must be submitted on a semiannual basis.
- Due 60 calendar days after the end of the applicable reporting period.
- The first report must be submitted within 240 days after the due date for the Compliance Status Notification report.
 - Must cover the 6-month period beginning on the due date of the Compliance Status Notification report.
 - Subsequent reports must be submitted for every 6-month period thereafter.

For Area Sources within a UA plus offset and UC boundary

- Must be submitted on an annual basis.
- Due 30 calendar days after the end of the applicable reporting period.
- The first report must cover the period beginning on the due date of the Notification of Compliance Status Report through December 31.
 - o Subsequent reports must cover January 1 through December 31.
