I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and Highway Motels of Nebraska, Inc., doing business as Highway Motels of Nebraska, Hall County, Nebraska, voluntarily enter into this Consent Order. This Consent Order establishes a new schedule of compliance for changes to the Respondent’s wastewater treatment facility necessary to achieve and maintain compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), the Nebraska Environmental Protection Act (NEPA), Neb. Rev. Stat. §81-1501 et seq. (Reissue 2008), Title 123, *Rules and Regulations for the Design, Operation and Maintenance of Wastewater Works* and Title 119, *Rules and Regulations Pertaining to the Issuance of Permits Under The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System*. The previously entered Administrative Order in this case shall stay in full force and effect, except paragraph 10, which following sections are amended to:

10. The Respondent shall perform the following activities:

...

f. By July 1, 2011 have an agreement in place to be connected to the City of Grand Island wastewater system, or:

- g. By September 1, 2011 - Begin Construction in accordance with plans and specifications as approved by NDEQ.
- h. By September 1, 2012 – Complete Construction in accordance with plans and specifications as approved by NDEQ.
- i. By December 1, 2012 – Be operating the WWTF as designed and constructed in accordance with plans and specifications as approved by NDEQ and meeting all permit limitations.
