IIJA vs. IRA

Two Separate and *Massive* Pieces of Federal Legislation with Lots of Funding Opportunities

IIJA

- Law in November 2021
- ~\$1.2T
- ~381 grant programs
- 5 Years (FY22 to FY26)
- Largest infrastructure bill passed in generations
- Bipartisan support

IRA

- Law in August 2022
- ~\$740b
- ~102 programs
- Mix of tax credits, incentives, loans, and grants
- 10 Years
- Biggest investment in clean energy/climate change by US ever
- Public Power finally eligible for tax credits!



OPPD's Approach to IIJA & IRA

- IIJA was passed 1st in November 2021
 - Organized an internal team of SMEs
 - Headed by Karisa Vlasek
 - Focus on competitive grants
- IRA was passed 2nd in August 2022
 - Organized an internal team focused on IRA opportunities
 - Headed by John Thurber, Director of Treasury & Financial Operations
 - Loans, tax credits, rebates, customer, community, grants
- Merge teams or keep separate?
 - Explored the idea of one larger team, but ultimately decided to keep two teams
- Teams meet separately month
 - Each team has breakout meetings
 - Karisa & John attend both meetings, coordinate information







OPPD Grant Strategy for IIJA & IRA

- Establish IIJA & IRA Teams
- How do we decide which grants and when to go after them?
 - Build on existing OPPD Grant Strategy & Prioritize Funding Areas
 - Need to prepare & move fast!
 - Grants due 60-90 days
 - Research, project information, budget
 - Identify Subject Matter Experts (SMEs), organize working groups
- Need to align internal resources
 - People, matching funds, balance with other project work, grant management & compliance if funded
- APPA is asking members not to share specifics on competitive grants



IIJA & IRA Grants are "Federal Grants on Steroids!"

Challenges

- Grant application timelines are very short!
- Complex Grant Process
 - Notice of Intent to Apply, Concept Paper
 - Have to be invited to apply by funding agency
 - Full grant application due in 30-60-90 days
- Grant Compliance Requirements
 - Justice 40/Community Benefits Plan, Buy American Build American, Davis Bacon Prevailing Wages, Job Creation, Apprenticeships, Audits, and so much more!

Opportunities

- Unprecedented Funding Opportunities
- IIJA: Biggest Infrastructure Investment in a Generation
 - Bipartisan support
- IRA: Largest climate investment in history
- Opportunity to impact communities most impacted by climate change, pollution, & environmental hazards
