NOTICE

*Administrative Extension of NPDES Construction Storm Water General Permit *

The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) general permit NER160000 for storm water discharges from construction sites, or "CSW general permit", has been extended beyond the expiration date of October 31, 2021, according to Title 119-*Rules and Regulations Pertaining to the Issuance of Permits Under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System*, Chapter 24. If you were authorized to discharge under this permit prior to the expiration date, any discharges under this permit will automatically remain covered by this permit until the earliest of:

- Your authorization for coverage under a reissued permit or a replacement of this permit following your timely and appropriate submittal of a complete Notice of Intent (NOI) requesting authorization to discharge under the new permit and compliance with the requirements of the new permit; or
- Your submittal of a Notice of Termination; or
- Issuance or denial of an individual permit for the facility's discharges; or
- A formal permit decision by the Department not to reissue this general permit, at which time the Department will identify a reasonable time period for covered dischargers to seek coverage under an alternative general permit or an individual permit. Coverage under this permit will cease at the end of this time frame.
