Closure Plan

A Closure Plan should include the following information:

1. Time Line – A schedule for activities (include notification to NDEQ when Closure Plan implemented and completed).
2. Dewatering Method - Equipment, how removed, where applied, etc.
3. Sludge / Sediment Handling - Equipment, how removed, etc. (could refer to Operational & Maintenance information, where appropriate).
4. Analysis of Sludge / Sediment / Soil Liner - at minimum for nitrogen & phosphorus.
5. Application Method / Location - equipment, description of application method (injection, incorporation, etc.), where applied, etc.

The Closure Plan could reference normal waste handling practices in the Nutrient Management Plan. For further information, see Title 130, “*Livestock Waste Control Regulations*,” Chapter 5, 003; Chapter 11, 010; and Chapters 12 and 14.
